As Districts prepare to enter Year 2 of Implementation and beyond, Reading Horizons provides in-person training focused on creating Sustainable Success. These Sustainable Success, in-person trainings are customizable with targeted two-hour segments. All sites will go through Segment One to review content from Chapters 1 through 4 and provide in-depth instruction in Chapter 5 skills (Kinder Segment One will review Chapters 1 and 2). The site then selects additional segments to best meet the needs of those attending the training. The options for the additional segments are listed below:

- Option A: Practice and Extended Transfer Activities
- Option B: Small-Group/Differentiated Instruction
- Option C: Effectively Using Decodable Text
- Option D: Using Data to Drive Your Instruction
- Option E: Most Common Words Instruction
- Option F: Games

Note: Three segments can be delivered in one day. This training allows for up to 25 attendees and costs \$7,000.

**Is coaching available for teacher implementing your materials?
If yes, please describe.***

Yes, coaching is available and encouraged. Reading Horizons works with teachers in the classroom mentoring and guiding on product implementation while helping districts work toward a trainer of trainer models to reduce future PD costs and improve implementation results.

In-person Coaching Days can be purchased for \$3,500. This session includes observation and feedback on the effective implementation of Reading Horizons instructional design. The facilitator will observe a full skill lesson (about 30 minutes) and provide immediate feedback. This entire process takes about 45–50 minutes per teacher. In a typical school day, facilitators can observe and give about five teachers feedback.
