We offer Leadership Walkthroughs as a support to school and district leadership. This modeling process involves shadowing the Carnegie Learning Implementation Manager as they demonstrate the walkthroughs and/or the formal coaching cycle with teachers. In order to provide opportunities for observation and reflection, master practitioners will model in-classroom support and coaching with teachers alongside district and campus instructional leaders and coaches. These shadowing opportunities focus primarily on demonstrating the skills of recognizing best instructional practices (via our look fors checklist), building relationships with teachers and supporting them in the development of their classroom practice and their use of *Mirrors & Windows* resources.
